

Rhayader Carnival Parade Code of Conduct

Prior to the Parade

Drivers and Group Leaders should ensure that the vehicle being used is Road legal and suitably insured for the activity.

Drivers and Group Leaders should ensure that no decoration is placed in a position that limits the driver's visibility.

Drivers and Group Leaders are to ensure that the lorry is suitably decorated in order that It can be identified as a carnival float and that all decorations are suitably fixed.

Drivers and Group Leaders are to ensure that there is a form of marker or barrier on the trailer edge so assist with safety (for example a ribbons or a defined colour change near the trailer edge.)

Drivers are to take the most direct route to the Smithfield prior to judging.

During the parade

Drivers and Group leaders are to encourage good levels of behaviour by all participants at all times.

Drivers are to follow instructions of Carnival Stewards and the Police.

Drivers are to drive in a suitable manner for the activity being carried out.

Drivers and group leaders are to promote the safety of all participants during the carnival parade.

After the Parade

Drivers where possible should stop and unload participants in to the Smithfield. If unable to unload in the Smithfield participants should be dropped off as near the Smithfield as possible.

Drivers should take the most direct route to the end destination.

Any vehicle with participants aboard Continuing along the Carnival Parade after completing the procession without instruction of the Carnival Stewards may be stopped and charged in accordance of the law.
